Notes:

**Basic** = support for first 256 characters in a font

**Unicode**® = support for multilingual characters (beyond 256 characters in a font)

**Pro** = support for typographic features in a font (small caps, old style figures, ligatures, etc.) Note that some applications only have limited Pro support.

**Type 1** = only supports standard roman character sets, or custom encoded fonts limited to 256 characters.

**TTF** = TrueType® or OpenType® TT format

**OTF** = OpenType PS font with PostScript® CFF font outlines
