This new sans serif design is suitable for interface design, corporate branding and publishing. Miramonte includes an alternative lowercase a, for those who have a stylistic preference over the original. The character set includes old style figures and accents for publishing Central and Eastern European languages.

The design is based on a sans serif released by Graphotechna in 1960 which included three weights but no italics. Stanislav Marso's design seemed more humanist than grotesque to this designer so an emphasis was put on the more approachable, humanist aspects of the design. This revival includes a cursive-style italic rather than a sloped roman.
